Lead Teacher of Health & Social Care 50% of TLR 2b (£2,690)

Thank you for your interest in this post. We are currently recruiting an outstanding teacher who will lead the Health & Social Care curriculum for The High School Leckhampton, which opened to Year 7 in September 2021 on our temporary site at Balcarras School. In September 2022 we moved to our £30 million, state-of the art building at Farm Lane, Leckhampton where we welcomed a new cohort of Year 7 pupils. The school will expand each year and we will take a new cohort of Year 7 annually, until it reaches a capacity of 900 pupils. From September 2024, we will have 540 pupils on roll in years 7-10. We are on a very exciting journey!

The High School Leckhampton is part of The Balcarras Multi Academy Trust, and we already work closely with Balcarras School. During our first year we were temporarily housed in a brand-new building on the site of Balcarras and shared several teachers and this close relationship has continued in year 3. Consequently, all applicants should look at the Balcarras Trust website for additional information about the ethos and culture of The Trust. Winchcombe School joined The Trust in November 2023 and subject networks are in place across all 3 schools.

At this time, we are looking to recruit a superb Health & Social Care teacher, who can establish our KS4 curriculum from September 2024. This is a unique opportunity to develop and lead the school's curriculum for Health & Social Care, create a 'flagship department', and make a significant contribution – in a variety of ways – to our ambitious school.

We are anticipating that there will be 1 GCSE group starting in Year 10 in September 2024. Therefore, we are interested to know which additional subject(s) applicants are confident to teach, until such time that the Health & Social Care cohort grows.

Similarly, as we are a new and growing school, we would be keen to hear if applicants are interested in taking an additional leadership role – such as Careers <u>or</u> PSHE. All skills and interests should be explained in your letter of application. Additionally, we are happy to consider applications from candidates who would like to teach on a *part-time basis*, increasing hours over time as the GCSE cohort grows.
